The Life of Prophet Muhammad

1. Introduction

Prophet Muhammad is a very important figure in Islam. He is loved and respected by Muslims all around the world.

2. Birth and Family

- **Birthplace:** Prophet Muhammad was born in the city of Makkah in the year 570 CE. The year was called the year of Elephant (the story is mentioned in Quran, in Surah Al fil.
 - **Parents:** His father's name was Abdullah ibn Abd Al Mutalib, and his mother's name was Amina binte Wahb.
 - **Grandfather:** Abd al Muttalib, who took care of him after his parents passed away. Unfortunately he also passed away when prophet SAW was 8 years old.
 - **Uncle:** His uncle Abu Talib, raised him after the death of his grandfather. He loved him, protected him and supported him.

3. Mission of Islam

When Prophet Muhammad (SAW) was 40 years old, he used to go to Cave Hira and seclude himself and his surroundings. He would think about everything around him and during that time, he received a special message from Allah through the angel Jibriel.

- **Islam:** Prophet Muhammad received messages from Allah about oneness of ALLAH and taught people to worship only one God.
 - **Teachings:** He emphasized kindness, honesty, and helping those in need.

4. Time in Makkah

- Prophet Muhammad started preaching Islam in Makkah and remained there for 13 years after prophethood.
 - As more people started following his teachings, some leaders in Makkah became upset and tried to harm him. So, on order from Allah, he and his followers migrated to a city called Madina in 622 CE.

5. Migration to Madina

- **Hijrah:** In 622 CE, Prophet Muhammad and his followers moved from Makkah to Madina. This event is known as the Hijrah. And it marks the start of the Islamic calendar.
 - In Madina, many people accepted Islam, and the Muslim community grew stronger.

6. Battles

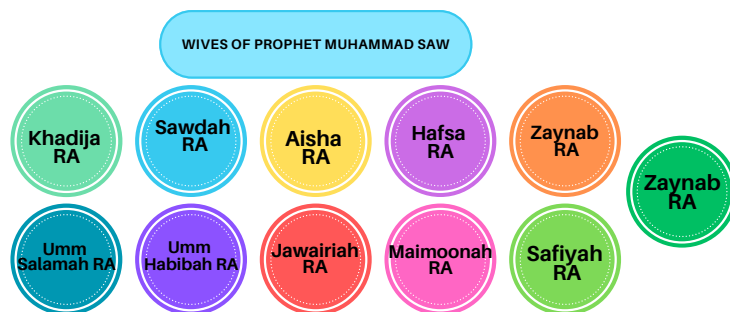
- **Battle of Badr:** The first major battle between the Muslims and the people of Makkah.
 - **Battle of Uhud:** Another significant battle where Muslims faced difficulties.
 - **Battle of the Khandak:** A defensive battle where Muslims dug a trench around Madina to protect it.

- **Kindness:** Prophet Muhammad was known for his kindness.
 - **Honesty:** He was called “Al-Amin,” which means “The Trustworthy.”
 - **Patience:** He showed great patience even when people were mean to him.

 - Zainab

 - Abdullah
 - Ibrahim
